Our Commodore Graeme Giles put his hand up to continue in this role for a further year, and his crew now consists of some old and some new members. Vice Commodore is Earl Pennington, Kath Barber has taken on the Secretary/Treasurer role, Cliff Bailie and Larry Andrews continue as Weigh Masters and a committee of Andrew Whyte, John Barber, Sheila Jackson and Mark Deacon were elected. A big thank you to Lorraine McLachlan for all her work for the Club over the years. She was given a bouquet of flowers and a year's membership in appreciation.

At the AGM at the end of June, it was agreed to add a new category of membership, and to this end, an Associate category has been included. This is for the partner of a Senior active member and for a subscription of \$10 a year, gives the member all the rights of club membership including a vote at general meetings and eligibility to hold office. So far, we have had 3 members take it up.

If you haven't already renewed your membership, please do so. This is best done on-line if possible. "Sign In" to your account and click on "renew membership". If you pay by credit card your account will automatically be activated. If you pay by bank deposit, your account will be activated once payment is received in the bank. At the AGM it was also agreed that we would undertake some improvements to the clubhouse facilities, including floor coverings, new outside curtains, tiling the bar and kitchen floors and new furniture. We plan to do this with the help of sponsorship and/or grants where possible and if necessary, utilise some of our reserve funds. We felt that this would make the clubhouse more attractive and welcoming and lend itself more to hiring out for some extra income.

We have accepted a quote from John Hewinson Canvas for the 10 outside curtains. It was suggested that we get a sponsor per curtain, and so far, we have 4 sponsors. Their name and logo will be sewn on the curtain and give them ongoing advertising for the life of the curtain, estimated to be at least 10 years. Snapper	weight equals score	e.g.	10 kg = 10 pts
Trevally	2 x weight equals score		5 kg = 10 pts
Kahawai	3 x weight equals score		3.33 kg = 10 pts
Gurnard	4 x weight equals score		2.5 kg = 10 pts
Tarakihi	4 x weight equals score		2.5 kg = 10 pts
John Dory	4 x weight equals score		2.5 kg = 10 pts
Kingfish	$\frac{1}{2}$ weight equals score		20 kg = 10 pts

Only one fish per fisher may be entered each month.

In the event of a tie, the winner will be drawn from those who are equal.

We have purchased a dedicated phone for the EFTPOS machine for the bar, which will make things a lot easier, especially for our tournaments and Mix and Mingle nights.

Our Mix and Mingle on Friday, 9 August was a cold night, but a number of hardy souls braved the elements and enjoyed the good food and company, the warmth of the pot belly stove, and a few fishy tales of course.
